Trip Itinerary

Day 1 (Wednesday, September 15) - New York/Beijing

Arrive at JFK International Airport and depart on flight CA982 by 3:30pm to Beijing. Your adventure begins as you fly trans-Pacific aboard a wide cabin jetliner and cross the International Dateline.

Day 2 (Thursday, September 16) - Beijing

Arrive in Beijing, the capital of China at 6:00pm. You will be met by your local tour guide at the airport. Transfer to the hotel after dinner.

Day 3 (Friday, September 17) - Beijing

Visit Tian An Men Square, the largest square in the world, the Palace Museum, also known as the Forbidden City and the Summer Palace.

Day 4 (Saturday, September 18) - Beijing

Tour bus excursion to the Great Wall and visit to the Ming Tombs. At the end of the day, enjoy a Roasted Beijing Duck Dinner.

Day 5 (Sunday, September 19) - Beijing/Shanghai/Suzhou

Morning flight to Shanghai, followed by a bus trip to Suzhou. Afternoon sightseeing includes the Lingering Garden, Tiger Hill and Hanshan Temple. Visit the National Embroidery Institute showcasing the 1,000 year history of the silk embroidery craft. Enjoy an evening dinner show with traditional Chinese music.

Day 6 (Monday, September 20) - Suzhou/Hangzhou

Morning tour bus journey to Hangzhou to visit the Economic Development Zone. Explore the centuries old Lingyin Temple, featuring a 64.3 foot high camphor wood carved Buddha.

Day 7 (Tuesday, September 21) - Hangzhou/Shanghai

Morning boat cruise on West Lake with relaxing stopover at jewel-like pagodas and tea houses. Afternoon tour bus trip to Shanghai.

Day 8 (Wednesday, September 22) - Shanghai

Sightseeing includes the Yu Garden, a maze of marvelous pavilions, ponds, and arching trees. Visit to the Bund, a famous waterfront park. Or, attend the World Expo 2010 Shanghai.

Day 9 (Thursday, September 23) - Shanghai/Beijing/New York

Morning flight to Beijing. Afternoon flight CA981 will depart by 1:00pm for JFK where you will arrive at 1:30pm on the same day.
